Parish Fundraising Update

At this time we would like to update you on our parish fundraising efforts.

Firstly, in order to meet this year's budget which ends on June 30th, we budgeted \$60,000 for fundraisers. To date our regular parish expenses are within our budget.

Keep in mind this did not include I.C.'s Air Conditioning or H.R.'S Rectory Roof. We have to meet these expenses by borrowing from our Parish savings, and our goal is to pay this rainy day fund back.

Our focus on helping the flood victims in our Greater Parish Community had no affect on our budget as everything was graciously donated, but it did curtail us from doing any fundraising.

On the positive side, our" Wish to Win" Lottery as well as our Night at the Races were a great success, raising \$21,000.

We have our "Green to Gold" lottery tickets on sale now, "In the Kitchen with Cheryl" on May 25^{th} , and our Parish Bazaar June 29^{th} , 30^{th} , and 31^{st} .

We have every confidence, with God's continued blessing, these events will be a great success, allowing our Parish to continue to serve as witness to the ideals of the faith which binds us together as Corpus Christi.
