## Diocese of Scranton.....Preventing the Flu

- 1) Share the Sign of Peace in a meaningful way without the traditional handshake.
- 2 Priests, Deacons, EM's etc are reminded to wash their hands before and after Mass.
- 3) For your protection, we are providing hand sanitizers at all entrances of the churches.

# Center for Disease Control & Prevention offers the following advice:

- 1. **Avoid close contact.** Avoid close contact with people who are sick. When you are sick, keep your distance from others to protect them from getting sick too.
- 2. **Stay home when you are sick.** If possible, stay home from work, school, and errands when you are sick. You will help prevent others from catching your illness.
- 3. Cover your mouth and nose. Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when coughing or sneezing. It may prevent those around you from getting sick.
- 4. Clean your hands. Washing your hands often will help protect you from germs.
- 5. Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth. Germs are often spread when a person touches something that is contaminated with germs and then touches his or her eyes, nose, or mouth.
- 6. **Practice other good health habits.** Get plenty of sleep, be physically active, manage your stress, drink plenty of fluids, and eat nutritious food
