On Friday, November 1st, All Saints Day we recognize all the saints of heaven in a universal celebration, a festival of the triumphant church of the resurrection in the new and holy city of Jerusalem. The saints, in a way are God's harvest. God has reaped the fruits of good sowing and gathered the mature faithful into the eternal storehouse.

November opens a season of the year when our thoughts turn toward the fear of death, the hope of eternal life, the gratitude we feel for God's gifts, and the charity we owe to others. In the northern hemisphere, trees turn barren and the chill of late fall settles in to stay.
