Religious Ed Registration

To help us begin preparation for Religious Education, we encourage you to register your children now. Classes, which will not start until the middle of September will be held on Sunday mornings at ICC & HR. Registration fee is \$25 per student (max \$50 per family. CCD Teachers & Volunteers
