### New organ for Immaculate Conception

We are faced with the need to replace the organ at Immaculate Conception Church. Through a bid process, Cunningham Piano was awarded the contract at a cost of \$61,296.00. The new organ will be installed the week of December 5, 2016. Through discussion and recommendation from the parish finance council the money was withdrawn from our diocesan savings account. Beginning January 2017 an "organ fund" envelope will appear monthly in with your envelopes. All donations received for this project will be deposited back into our diocesan savings account. Monthly reports on the donation progress will appear in the bulletin.
