PLEASE REMEMBER.....


- "The obligation to attend Mass and the sacraments remains suspended."

Parish Census

As you all are probably aware, volunteers have been helping us update our parish census. They have and continue to make calls to parishioners asking for updated information. In some instances, we do not have current phone numbers nor do we have an email address. In the near future, we will be sending a letter and a parish census form to those we could not reach by phone asking you to fill it out and return it to us. As always, thank you for your help with keeping our records current.

Religious Education Fall 2020

This fall Religious Education in our parish will be different than in the past. This past week our Religious Education teachers met and devised a plan for the fall of 2020. Last year we had 145 children



enrolled in our Religious Ed classes. Out of that 10 children were homeschooled. Thirty of those children (2nd graders) received the Sacrament of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist this year. In the last 2 weeks of August, 35 young men and women who finished 8th grade will receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in our parish.

Second Grade

Only children in second grade, who will be preparing to receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist will be attending classes on site. Of course, the parents/guardians of the second grade students will have the option to homeschool. Children attending classes here will be required to wear masks and social distance. There will be 8 children in a classroom. Classes for these children will be held every other Sunday morning or twice a month.

Eighth Grade

Students in Eighth Grade, who will be preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in 2021, will NOT have classes on site. Deacon Jim Meizanis, who has been teaching this age group, will have "virtual" classes this fall.

•Grades K, 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7

Parents/guardians of students in these remaining grades will have the option to homeschool their children. Before the end of August, a letter will be sent to all the families who had children registered in our Religious Education program last year. If you are new to the parish and have children of school age, please call the rectory or e mail Joyce at 570-654-2753 and we will gladly include you in this mailing.
