can be homeschooled. Because they are preparing to receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation & First Eucharist, attending class or homeschooling is required for students in Grade 2.

•Students in Grade 8 who are preparing to receive the Sacsrament of Confirmation, will be taught virtually twice a month.

•Students enrolled in Catholic School are not required to attend Religious Ed classes.

•The Religious Ed Team will meet in December and if needed, will devise a plan for the remainder of the 2021 school year.

•A letter and registration form has been mailed to families of students in our Religious Education program.

Today, Saturday, September19th and next Saturday, September 26th, you can attend the 5:30PM Mass at Holy Redeemer while remaining in your car. Just stay in your car and open the windows.
