Religious Education Fall 2020

•Students in Grades 1,3,4,5,6, & 7 are not required, but are welcome to be homeschooled. No in-person classes will be available for these grades this fall.

•Students in Grade 2 can attend class here (Sunday morning-twice a month) or they

can be homeschooled. Because they are preparing to receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation & First Eucharist, attending class or homeschooling is required for students in Grade 2.

•Students in Grade 8 who are preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation will be taught virtually twice a month.

•Students enrolled in Catholic School are not required to attend Religious Ed classes.

•The Religious Ed Team will meet in December and if needed, will devise a plan for the remainder of the 2021 school year.

•A letter and registration form has been mailed to families of students in our Religious Education program.
