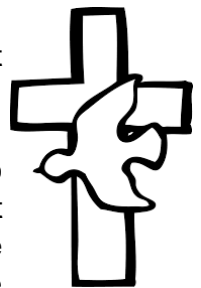
Sacraments of First Reconciliation & First Eucharist



Boys and girls who are in 2nd grade are eligible to receive the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist this year. Due to the limitations COVID has placed on us, we do not have a definite date set for either of these Sacraments. If your second grade child is enrolled in public school, he/she should be registered in the parish Religious Education program, whether attending classes here or at home. Students enrolled in Catholic school do not have to attend Religious Education classes at the parish. But please contact Joyce at the rectory 570-654-2753 or e-mail icecconi50@gmail.com to register your child to receive the Sacraments.

Sacrament of Confirmation

Students enrolled in eighth grade in a public school must be registered in our "virtual" Religious Education program to be eligible to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Students attending a Catholic School do not have to attend classes here, but please call Joyce at 570-654-2753 or icecconi50@gmail.com to be eligible to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. As of now we do not have a definite date set for this Sacrament.

You can remain in your car and listen to any of our weekend liturgies. Whether you choose to attend 4:00PM or 5:30PM Mass on Saturday or the 7:30AM, 9:00AM or 10:30AM Mass on Sunday, you can do so by remaining in your car.

To listen to Mass from the Immaculate Conception Church parking lot, tune your radio to FM 90.3 and to listen to Mass from the Holy Redeemer Church parking lot, tune into FM 89.3. At the conclusion of Mass, you will be directed to receive Holy Communion without having to enter the church.

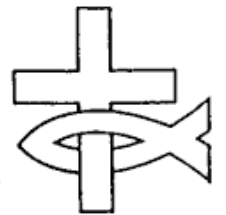
Diocesan Secretary for Property & Risk Management
