**Distribution of Ashes during Mass**

Ashes will be distributed outside of church 15 minutes prior to the start of Mass for those who do not want to enter the church. If you are going to Mass, you will be directed by an usher to your seat and an extraordinary minister will give you ashes with a Q tip as you enter your pew.

**Distribution of Ashes, ONLY**

For the distribution of ashes only at 12 Noon, 3:30PM and 5:00PM. No ashes will be given in church. At ICC ashes will be distributed outside the side door (rectory side of the church) and at HR at the curb in front of the main entrance.

**Pre-Packaged Ashes**

Ashes have been blessed, packaged and are available to take home and distribute to the elderly, family members, or friends who are not comfortable coming into church. Our Extraordinary Ministers will have them available at all services.

**Second Collection Ash Wednesday**

There will be a diocesan 2nd collection on Ash Wednesday to benefit the Church in Central & Eastern Europe. Your generosity is appreciated. Thank you.

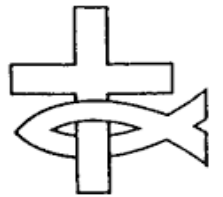
