From the Diocese of Scranton.....

The following health and safety guidelines are in effect for Masses and other parish events. Due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the emphasis remains on mitigating the spread of the virus by wearing masks, promoting proper hand hygiene and maintaining an appropriate physical distance from other individuals. Parishes must continue to be vigilant in order to protect all of the faithful.

Mandated by the Diocese:

- Seating in our churches is now every other pew.
- Holy Communion is now restored to its proper place in Mass.
- It is recommended you receive Holy Communion in the hand. If you wish to receive by mouth, we ask that you wait until everyone has received.
- You must enter the churches thru the main doors and the ushers will seat you.
- After Mass, you can now exit any door of the church.
- During the Sign of Peace, there will be no physical contact between non-family members.
- Audio parking lot weekend Masses will continue.
- Weekday and weekend Masses will continue to be taped and shown on You Tube and Facebook.

●It is still recommended the collection be taken using a stationary basket. For your convenience, there are baskets for your donations at all entrances and all exits.

●Masks will continue to be worn during Mass. When receiving communion, move the mask down to consume the host, then return the mask to its proper place (covering the nose and mouth). Children under the age of 2 do not have to wear a mask.

●Regular sanitizing of the churches will continue.

●The obligation to attend Mass is still suspended until further notice.
