Diocese of Scranton....Guidelines for Masses

- Individuals who are fully vaccinated from COVID-19 are not required to wear masks while attending Mass. Fully vaccinated individuals are welcome to continue wearing masks at Mass if desired for personal protection and/or comfort.
- Individuals who have NOT been fully vaccinated MUST continue to wear masks while attending Mass and receiving Holy Communion, only removing it briefly to consume the host.
- All individuals aged two or older who are not fully vaccinated, must wear a mask while attending Mass.
- Priests, Deacons and Extraordinary Ministers of Communion are still required to wear a face mask during the Distribution of Holy Communion even if they are fully vaccinated.
- All parishes MUST post signage in all entrance areas stating that anyone who is not fully vaccinated is expected to wear a mask and anyone with COVID-19 symptoms should not enter.
- At no time should church leaders demand information about vaccination status (or any other protected health information), request vaccination cards be shown on admittance, or pressure attendees in any way to show proof of vaccination. When in doubt, parishes should continue to plan their gatherings with the caution that some participants may be unvaccinated.
- We will continue to sanitize the churches daily.
