Mask Guidance for Masses

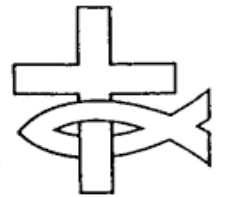
●As of Monday, June 28, 2021, the Pa Dept of Health ended its mask mandate. Therefore, in parishes in the Diocese of Scranton, there is no requirement for face coverings or masks.

●An individual is welcome to continue wearing masks if desired for personal protection and/or comfort.

●Priests, Deacons and Extraordinary Ministers of Communion will no longer be required to wear a face mask during the Distribution of Holy Communion. They still have the discretion to wear a face mask during the distribution of Holy Communion if they choose.

●It is encouraged that the Sign of Peace be celebrated without physical contact.
