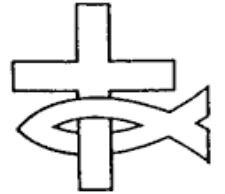
Sacraments of First Reconciliation/First Eucharist

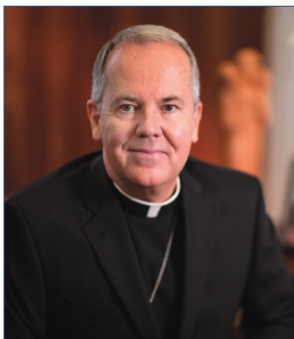

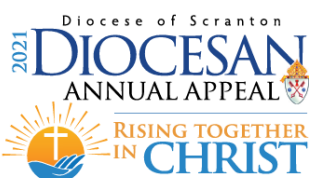
