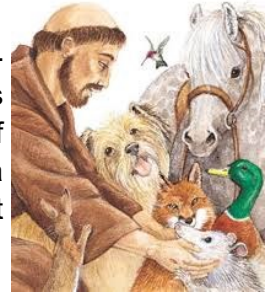

Steph's Fall 5k: T-shirt Fundraiser

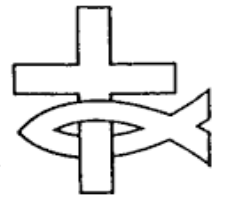
