### **New Mass Schedule**

The Transition Team for the parishes of St Barbara and Corpus Christi met on Monday, March 21, 2022 to continue discussions and preparation for the linkage of our two parishes. We prayerfully considered all possible options for creating the new Mass Schedule.

In developing this Mass Schedule, the Transition Team studied factors such as minimizing disruption for parishioners, appreciation of times for Religious Education and families already attending Mass, expected Saturday funerals and weddings and allowing sufficient time for the pastor to travel, prepare and interact with parishioners. In assessing average attendance, particularly of weekend Masses, The Transition Team carefully considered the impact that the Covid pandemic has had on attendance during the past two years. The ultimate goal was to create a new Mass schedule that could be accomplished by one priest on a regular basis, while giving precedent to all of the above elements of parish life.

After extensive conversation, prayer and exploring multiple options it was the consensus of the Transition Team that the following Mass Schedule will begin on May 2, 2022.
