With the help of the Diocese of Scranton, our linked parishes continue to combine ministries (including our Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, our Lectors, our incredibly talented Choir, and our Pastoral Council) and look for ways to further build community between the St. Barbara's and Corpus Christi Parishes. We have now been linked for nearly a year. The long- term hope and goal remains that we will one day become one parish community which the Catholic Church refers to as "consolidation." Toward that goal, we sought Diocesan input on how to assure the process is inclusive and uplifting for the parishioners of both communities. They suggested that we prioritize great transparency regarding the finances of the two parishes. In that spirit and at the direction of Bishop Bambera and Monsignor Sempa, all data about the income and expenses of both parish communities was placed in the combined bulletin and parishioners are to receive continued updates regarding finances.

As a further step toward transparency, the Diocese recently recommended to our combined Parish Pastoral Council that we secure expert evaluations of the physical condition and needs of each of the facilities within the St. Barbara's and Corpus Christi communities. This information, the Diocese explained, will help to assure that parishioners from both parish communities have a clear picture of the financial obligations and challenges that our respective parishes must anticipate in terms of capital investment and upkeep as we go forward. These evaluations do not include the St. Cecilia's church property which is to be sold once the WAC School parking lot is complete.

Against this backdrop, the Diocese recommended multiple companies who have successfully performed facility evaluations in the past. The Quandel Company, based in Harrisburg but with significant experience working locally, was selected. Quandel's quote for services was by far the most cost-effective for the extensive information being sought with a total cost not to exceed \$6,206.00 for Corpus Christi facilities and a total cost not to exceed \$5,188.00 for St. Barbara's facilities broken down as follows: Corpus Christi: Holy Redeemer site: Church, Rectory, Garage, (not to exceed \$2508.00), Immaculate Conception site: Church, Rectory, School (not to exceed \$3698.00); St Barbara site: Church, Rectory, Garage, Pavilion and Hall/Classrooms, not to exceed \$5,188.00.

With the support of Monsignor Sempa, the Pastoral Council will assure that the results of the evaluations are shared with parishioners in both of our linked-parish communities. The collective prayer of Monsignor and our Pastoral Council is that this open exchange of information between our linked parishes will foster ever greater trust and confidence among our fellow parishioners and help build the foundation for one marvelous faith-filled parish community in the future.


# Notice to the Roman Catholic Faithful of the Diocese of Scranton regarding Saints Francis and Clare Progressive Catholic Community

On Sunday, May 14, 2023, the Saints Francis & Clare Progressive Catholic Community reopened the former Saint Mary of Czestochowa Church building in Moosic for worship. The Diocese of Scranton sold the church property in September 2014 during a previous parish consolidation process.

In response to questions that have been received, we wish to remind the faithful that the Progressive Catholic Church is neither affiliated with the Diocese of Scranton nor in communion with the universal Catholic Church.

The faithful of the Diocese of Scranton should not attend Masses nor receive the sacraments provided by the Progressive Catholic Church community. Particularly regarding the sacraments of Confession and Marriage, these celebrations would not only be illicit, but also invalid.
