Dear Parishioners.

As you know, last week's bulletin contained a financial Trend Analysis for the then linked parishes of Corpus Christi and St. Barbara's. The Trend Analysis was prepared by the Diocese utilizing information provided by our parish. To help assure that you appreciate the continuing need for your kind generosity to our consolidated parish community, we must note that the St. Barbara's Trend Analysis for 2024 does not clarify that the \$280,300.00 grant from Luzerne County was earmarked and utilized exclusively to offset the cost of construction of the new Wyoming Area Catholic School parking lot. Removing the grant from the income results in a deficit of (\$13,535.00) for St. Barbara's.
