Our next meeting will be held tomorrow **Monday, February 17th at 7:00PM in the rectory.** All men of the parish are welcome to attend.

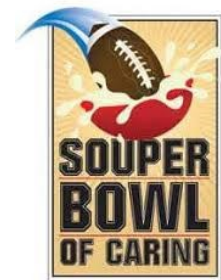

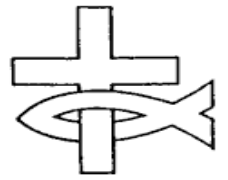
**A Polish Lenten Food Sale**
